

## **Affinity Lottery**

Affinity Lottery has been setup to enable charities and local councils to tap into the power of fundraising through a local lottery. The Parish Council would like to hear your views whether you would be interested in a Mobberley Lottery.



### **Friends of Mobberley Station**

The Friends of Mobberley Station are a small group of local residents who volunteer to keep the platforms at the station looking colourful, clean and tidy. We worked hard during 2023 to get rid of all the overgrown weeds and ivy that had taken over the flower borders. We then met every few weeks for a couple of hours and planted perennials as well as summer flowering plants along the platforms and in the new



flower barrels along each side of the track. At the end of last year the barrels were planted with spring bulbs and they are just starting to pop up now ready for

a colourful show in a few weeks.

We have recently acquired a new notice board in the Manchester bound shelter, which has been provided by CrossCountry, so we are able to put up information about our own activities and those going on in Mobberley.

Also, if you have used the station recently you will have noticed that there has been an improvement to the safety at the edge of the track. There is a new yellow line down the length of each platform, and passengers are required to stay behind this while waiting for their train. Also, to help the blind and partially sighted new tactile paving flags have been laid on the platform edges.




