Mobberley Parish Council Update

Mobberley Parish Council meetings and Council Committee meetings take place at the Rajar Building. All the meeting agendas can be found on two noticeboards (one outside the Rajar Building and the other in Knolls Green), as well as on the Council's website at www.mobberleyparishcouncil.co.uk

Full council meetings are usually held on the first Monday of the month, except August, at 7pm.

The April meeting will be held on Monday 15 April (due to Easter Monday) Committee meetings in April are as follows:

- 15 April 6.30pm Planning Committee
- 22 April 7pm Finance Committee
- 29 April 7pm Rajar Committee.

The meetings are open to the public and Mobberley Parish Council welcomes the interaction with its residents. If you wish to raise a question, please notify the Clerk three clear days prior to the meeting.

Invitation to join us for our Annual Parish Meeting

The Annual Parish Meeting is open to all to come along and hear about the work of the Parish Council over the previous financial year. This annual meeting not only provides an opportunity for residents to speak to councillors about the work they have carried out in Mobberley but also to suggest future projects to the Parish Council.

This year, we have a guest speaker who will be introducing the important work of the Lindow Moss Landscape Partnership. The presentation will highlight the important work the Partnership is doing to conserve, restore and interpret the wider Lindow Moss landscape for the benefit of nature, the climate and people. Much of this landscape falls within Mobberley Parish.

The Annual Parish Meeting will take place on 13 May at 7pm at the Rajar Building. Refreshments will be served after the presentations.

Mobberley Neighbourhood Plan Regulation 14 Consultation

Members of the Mobberley Neighbourhood Plan Working Group have been developing the Neighbourhood Plan since 2022 and now have a final draft, which we are asking village residents' opinions of.

This is our six-week Regulation 14 Pre-Submission Consultation, starting at 8am on 18 March 2024 and ending at 5pm on 3 May 2024.

The Neighbourhood Plan outlines the vision and objectives for Mobberley, presented in the form of individual policies, and can be viewed on our website at www.mobberleyparishcouncil.co.uk/neighbourhood-plan, or in hard copy at the Rajar Building, Town Lane, WA16 7ER. A drop-in event is being held at the Rajar Building on 22 April, 6–7pm. This will provide an opportunity to view the Plan and ask the team any questions.

Please let us know your ideas on the Plan, including anything you support, don't support or would like to be presented differently.



FOOTPATH ON NEWTON HALL LANE UPDATE

I'm so pleased to see the siding-out work on the footpath has now taken place. It has taken a few months to get this work on the job list, but after a meeting with Highways Officers and some agreement to use my highways allocation, the work is done!

A lot of residents have been asking for this work and it is now complete.

We have a nice wide pavement yet again and I hope residents feel safer again on this stretch of road.

FAULKNER'S LANE SPEED LIMIT CHANGE UPDATE

I am pleased to have had confirmation that the risk of speed and the need to review the speed limit has been accepted by Cheshire East Council.

After all of your support, filling in my questionnaire and attending my surgeries, the road has met the criteria to be added to the next stage of the review. The work needed will be costed and 10 roads out of the 30 that met the criteria will be selected. The remaining 20 roads will be scheduled in at a later date.

I am hoping we make the top 10! I have submitted all evidence asked for and provided a compelling argument.
